## Parent Update – WA Premier’s Announcement of the planned return to pre-lockdown conditions, as experienced prior to 6pm, 31 January.

I am writing on behalf of the School’s Senior Leadership Team to update you of the announcement today from the Premier Mr. Mark McGowan advising that, subject to no new positive cases, Western Australia would return to conditions experienced prior to 6:00pm 31 January, from 12.01am on Sunday 14 February 2021.

- Subject to a final announcement from the WA Premier, as of **Monday 15 February**, students will not be required to wear masks at school, both inside and outside the classroom.
- All Staff, Parents/Guardians and visitors do not need to wear masks while on campus.
- Parents/Guardians and visitors may access School grounds to attend meetings and for drop off and pick up purposes. They do not need to scan in using the Safe WA app as they enter or sign the contact register. They will still need to sign in at the School Office as usual and obtain a Visitor’s Pass if they are staying for a pre-arranged meeting.
- Physical distancing of one adult per two square metres and good hygiene practices will continue to apply.
- In keeping with physical distancing requirements, parents are asked not to enter the classrooms.
- The normal School drop off and pick up schedule will return for Primary students.

On behalf of the School Staff, I would like to commend our wonderful students, and sincerely thank them and our families for the supportive way in which they have responded to the conditions of the last fortnight.

May we continue to trust in the Lord to uphold us through these times.
