

Getting involved in School Banking is easy!

All you need to get involved in the School Banking program is a Commonwealth Bank Youthsaver account. You can open an account for your child in one of two ways:

home until they are completely well. Children who come back still heavily affected by their illness can't concentrate and infect other students.






