**Dear Parents and Guardians** 

Thank you for your support throughout the most recent COVID-19 crisis in Western Australia.

The Western Australian Premier Mark McGowan has outlined the plan for Perth and the Peel Region to transition out of lockdown **from midnight tonight, Monday 26 April.** 

After reviewing the easing of restrictions by the WA Government and acting on advice from the Western Australian Health Department, the latest COVID-19 response plan for Emmanuel Christian Community School is as follows:

Students and Staff will be able to attend school from Tuesday 27 April 2021, with interim restrictions put in place by WA Government for the rest of this week.

The following conditions will apply:

#### Parents/Guardians and Visitors on School Grounds:

#### Please avoid coming onto the campus unless it is necessary.

Parents/Guardians and visitors may come on to the school site to attend pre-arranged meetings, School business and for drop off and pick up purposes only. This maximum number is limited and physical distancing of one person per 4 square metres and good hygiene practices applies. In addition:

- All Parents/Guardians and visitors will need to wear masks while on campus.
- Masks are required to be worn by all school staff.
- Masks are required to be worn by all secondary students.
- Primary Students are not required to wear masks.
- All Parents/Guardians and visitors will need to scan the QR Codes using the SafeWA App or sign in the contact register when entering the School. The School QR Codes will be displayed on signage around the entrances of each Campus for convenience.

- Signing in will be mandatory for Parents/Guardians and visitors at the School Receptions.
- Parents/Guardians and visitors need to adhere to the signage reminders of physical distancing and hygiene measures when on the School campus.
- Where possible, please continue to use the 'Kiss and Drive' at drop off and pick up of children.
- Due to physical distancing requirements, Year 1 to 6 Parents/Guardians may not enter classrooms and we would ask that Year 7 to Year 12 Parents only enter the school grounds if necessary.

• Please contact teachers to pre-arrange all meetings where required.

## **Kindergarten and Pre-Primary Classes**

- Kindergarten and Pre-Primary Parents/Guardians may enter the campus before and after school to drop off and pick up their child.
- We ask that Parents/Guardians do not enter their child's classroom.
- Parents need to wear masks.
- Scan in with the School QR Codes.
- Use the hand sanitizer at the door of the classroom.
- Please stay for no more than 5 minutes outside the classroom to settle children.

## **Swimming Lessons:**

Years 3-5 swimming lessons will be cancelled this week as the venue will be closed.

### Year 9 Camp:

**Year 9 Camp will be able to continue** with masks being worn by students and teachers.

The School will continue to act on advice from the Western Australian Government, the Western Australian Health Department, the Association of Independent Schools Western Australia (AISWA) and the Department of Education. This includes continued extra cleaning of high contact areas at school and good hygiene practices.
