COVID-19 UPDATE

New measures for schools and childcare were announced this afternoon and will take effect from tomorrow **Tuesday 8**th **February.**

The aim of these measures is to keep schools and childcare settings open and operating safely. **Beginning tomorrow, the following measures will apply at Emmanuel:**

- Parents can continue to drop-off and pick-up students but are not permitted to enter classrooms.
- As far as possible, parents should minimise entry into school grounds. If your child is a little anxious, please escort to staff waiting at classrooms.
- We ask parents to leave school grounds promptly and avoid gathering on school site.
- Parent-teacher meetings, Primary MEET THE TEACHER and Secondary Year information evenings are cancelled or postponed. Any future meetings will be held online.
- All camps are postponed or cancelled.
- No choir classes.
- No swimming lessons.
- Steps already taken at Emmanuel to minimise student/staff movement remain in place.
- Sign in, mask wearing and social distancing are required of all staff and parents, at all times, even outdoors if you enter school grounds as social distancing cannot be maintained.
- Secondary students should come to school with a mask. We have limited supplies of masks and cannot continue to provide daily.
